LOCATION CHANGE AND CO-SPONSOR Dialogue on Diversity's Colloquium and Reception in observance of Domestic Violence Awareness Month has a new venue — the Josephine Butler Parks Center, at **2437 FIFTEENTH STREET, N.W., WASHINGTON, D.C.**, across from Meridian Hill Park. We have entry to this elegant setting through the courtesy of our Co-Sponsor for the event, the Latino Federation of Greater Washington, a civic organization having its offices in this restored mansion, a Washington classic. The initially announced site, the rooftop garden at Seventeenth and Pennsylvania, will be saved for a date when the climate may be more merciful. We very gratefully welcome the Latino Federation on the masthead for this program.

How to reach the new site – By Metro (subway), take the Green line to *Columbia Heights Station at 16th and Irving*, N.W. Walk south four blocks on *Sixteenth Street*. Turn left at *Euclid*, walk the short block to *Fifteenth* and turn right. The mansion at 2437 is half way down the block. By car: Take *Sixteenth Street*, to *W Street* at foot of the redesigned Meridian Hill Park. Proceed one block on W to *Fifteenth*, *turn left and proceed up hill to 2437*. *NOTE: FIFTEENTH STREET IS ONE WAY NORTH. YOU MUST ENTER AT W TO REACH 2437.*

The program of October 23 brings together a panel of concerned workers representing a variety of non-profit social service groups, all in the thick of aiding minority communities in the multiple dimensions of the domestic violence problem.
